1979 – Christmas Offering Project is founded by Karole and Floyd Kettering in a spare room in their home in Wheaton, Illinois. Helped 35 needy families the first year.

2010 Christmas Offering Project served **456 families** and **1,198 children** with 42,000 lbs. of food and more than 6,000 gifts.

2006 – Present: School Supplies Project distributed school supplies to **5,200 needy children in 2010.**

Humanitarian Service Project Mission:

To alleviate the pain and suffering that poverty brings to needy seniors and children in our communities.

1982 – Present: Senior Citizen Project - monthly deliveries of 90 lbs. of nutritious food to low-income seniors, along with Secret Pal gifts and Holiday Meals. 1,440 deliveries made to **120 needy seniors.**

130,000 lbs. of food distributed in 2010.

2004 – Present: Feed the Kids Project, provides families whose children receive free or reduced-cost lunches during the school year with 750 lbs. of food over the summer months. Currently serves **100 families, 454 kids.** Adding 50 more families this year.

75,000 lbs. of food distributed in 2010.

1992 – Present: Children's Birthday Project provides a 25 lb. Birthday Box of gifts and party supplies to give **700 impoverished children** a "special day". Adding 50 more children this year.
